

Speed Limits

Roads - 20 miles per hour

Parking Lots - 5 miles per hour

Parking Lots and Color-Coded Stalls

All vehicles must be parked in assigned lots.

No vehicles will be permitted along the sides of roads or outside marked parking stalls.

Obey signs posted at each lot. All students must park in **WHITE**-striped parking stalls.

Student decals are not required as the College police can match Motor Vehicle and student records. All Staff members must park in

GREEN-striped stalls. Visitor's spaces are

not to be used by students or staff. Visitors may park in the yellow or white spaces.

BLUE-striped stalls are for disabled persons only. Staff must display parking decals for

authorized parking. **YELLOW** striped stalls are for visitors only and must display valid

parking permits.

Permission for pick-up or drop-off in

restricted areas must be obtained from the College Police prior to parking.

In the event a vehicle is disabled and is in

violation of any of the campus parking regulations, it is the responsibility of the

driver to notify the College Police immediately of its location, and to have it moved as soon

as possible.



Emergency Procedures

- In cases of emergency call **911** or **732.906.2500** or use the emergency phones located throughout campus.
- In case of motor vehicle accidents, loss by theft, vehicle breakdown, or in any injury, call College Police Headquarters at 732.906.2500 or use any emergency phone located throughout the Edison Campus. All accidents and thefts, no matter how minor, must be reported to the College Police.

Welcome to Middlesex County College! Enclosed please find your Middlesex County College **Parking Information** for this academic year.

Please take time to familiarize yourself with our rules and regulations listed within, and if you have any questions regarding our rules and regulations, please call our **Traffic Office** at 732.548.6000 extension 3500.

The traffic office is open Monday through Friday between 8 a.m. and 7 p.m.

It should be understood that parking is a privilege, not a right. The acceptance of parking privileges and the presence of any vehicle on the campus represents agreement by you the motorist, that Middlesex County College is in no way liable for personal injury, damage, or loss of part, or contents of, the vehicle.

The College welcomes parents and visitors to campus. **Visitor** parking areas are easily identified. Vehicles parked in violation of the rules and regulations may be towed at the owner's expense. **Students** and College personnel must acquaint guests with parking and traffic regulations.

In case of a motor vehicle **accident**, loss by theft, vehicle breakdown, or any injury, call College Police headquarters at 732.906.2500 or use any emergency phone located in the classroom buildings throughout the Edison Campus. There are outside **emergency** phones located in front of West Hall, the Johnson Learning Center, and in parking lots 4, 5, 6 and 6A. Both the emergency phones located inside the buildings and the emergency phones located outside connect to the police department directly. **All** accidents and theft, no matter how minor, must be reported to the College Police.



The Middlesex County College Police officers are commissioned under the State of New Jersey Title 18A: 6-4.2, and in accordance with **state laws**, have "...all powers of police and constables in criminal cases and offenses against the law..." as well as the **authority** to enforce New Jersey motor vehicle laws, local ordinances, and College rules and regulations. The Police Department provides vehicle, bicycle, and foot patrols on campus 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year.

Parking

All student parking lots and all staff parking lots are available on a first-come, first-served basis.

- Student parking is designated in the following areas only: Parking Lot 1, 1A, 2, 4, 6, and 6A.
- Disabled persons must display a **valid** State authorized permit or a temporary disabled permit issued by the College Nurse.

Payment of Fines

Fines may be paid by mail or in person either at the Cashier's office between 8:30 a.m. and 4 p.m. or at Police Headquarters between 8 a.m. and 7 p.m. Monday through Friday. Checks or money orders should be made **payable** to Middlesex County College. Payment by credit card can be accepted at the cashier's office as well.

Parking Verification

Student parking verification is made in cooperation with the Department of Motor Vehicles and the Division of Traffic of the Middlesex County College Police Department. **ALL** vehicles not meeting the requirements of Middlesex County College are subject to parking citation(s) and/or towed at the owner's expense.

Towing

Any vehicle in **violation** of College regulations is subject to towing at the owner's expense. No vehicle will be released until the towing fee has been paid. Towing fees are set by the towing company.
