

“We’ll Spring for Spring!” Contest Rules

1. Contest dates will be determined by Blue Colt Radio. The winner will be announced at our end of semester party on Thursday, December 6th at 3:30pm.
2. The method of entry: Applicants will purchase a bag of candy for \$1.00 and then complete a ballot for entry. For each bag they purchase they are allowed 1 entry in to the contest.
3. All prize winners are required to pick up their prize at the Blue Colt Studios, room 308 in the College Center located on the Main Campus in Edison (unless otherwise instructed). The address is 2600 Woodbridge Avenue, Edison, New Jersey, 08818.
4. All prizes must be claimed within thirty (30) days of notification that the prize is available to be claimed. Prizes unclaimed after thirty (30) days of notification will be forfeited. Alternate methods of picking up prizes may be determined by Blue Colt Radio.
5. Prizes are not redeemable for cash equivalent and are not transferable.
6. Winners must sign a release form for all prizes.
7. If a contestant is declared a winner, and it is determined that the winner failed to meet a requirement, disqualification and relinquishment of the prize could result.
8. Blue Colt Radio is not responsible for any loss, damage, and/or injury arising from the use of any prize awarded by the station.
9. Winners must show legal identification to claim prize.
10. No purchase necessary.
11. Prizes are not transferable. No case equivalent will be offered in substitution of prize. No prizes may be substituted or exchanged for other prizes.

21. All applicants must validate their student status on campus with an MCC I.D., and/or a schedule from the Registrar’s Office.

Blue Colt Radio may be excused from its obligation to execute the contest if its performance is delayed or prevented due to causes beyond its control, including but not limited to acts of God, public enemies, terrorism, war, civil disorder, fire, flood, explosion, labor disputes or strikes, and any acts by any governmental authority.
