Once you have figured out the person's cohesive story, then you will convey it in a creative way. We will be using the free website Story Bird which you will create an account for. Simply tell the person's story! Creativity is welcomed! The submission format will be guided by your creativity.

Rubric:

Criteria	Possible Points	Description
Use of All Pieces of Information	0-20	Within your project, make sure you integrate all 13 pieces of information. For each piece of information, be sure to state/explain how this would impact their development/life.
Cohesiveness of Story	0-50	This will be the most difficult aspect of this project. Make sure that you tie all the pieces of information together to tell a cohesive story. For example, how does the individual's infant attachment style influence how they will interact with romantic partners as they get older? Try to avoid contradictions within the story across multiple pieces of information.
Creativity	0-20	Think outside the box! Have some fun with this aspect of the project. Use your divergent thinking skills to guide you on this criterion.
Quality of the Project	0-10	This criterion addresses how good your overall product is in regards to writing and how it looks. Having typos or grammatical errors or not enough information or a good amount of interesting aspects will bring your score on this criterion down.
