1. On this bottom part you can allow the students to have multiple attempts on a question

2. Provide a time when students will be able review their answers from the quiz

3. Allow the questions to be seen one at a time

4. Provide restriction by access code or IP address (usually left unchecked)

5. Provide who it is going to be assigned to (ether a person, several persons or an entire section. If you are doing this for separate sections on separate days then you will need to redo for each class

you can then set the date and time available as well as the ending time\*\*\*all dialog boxes need to be filled

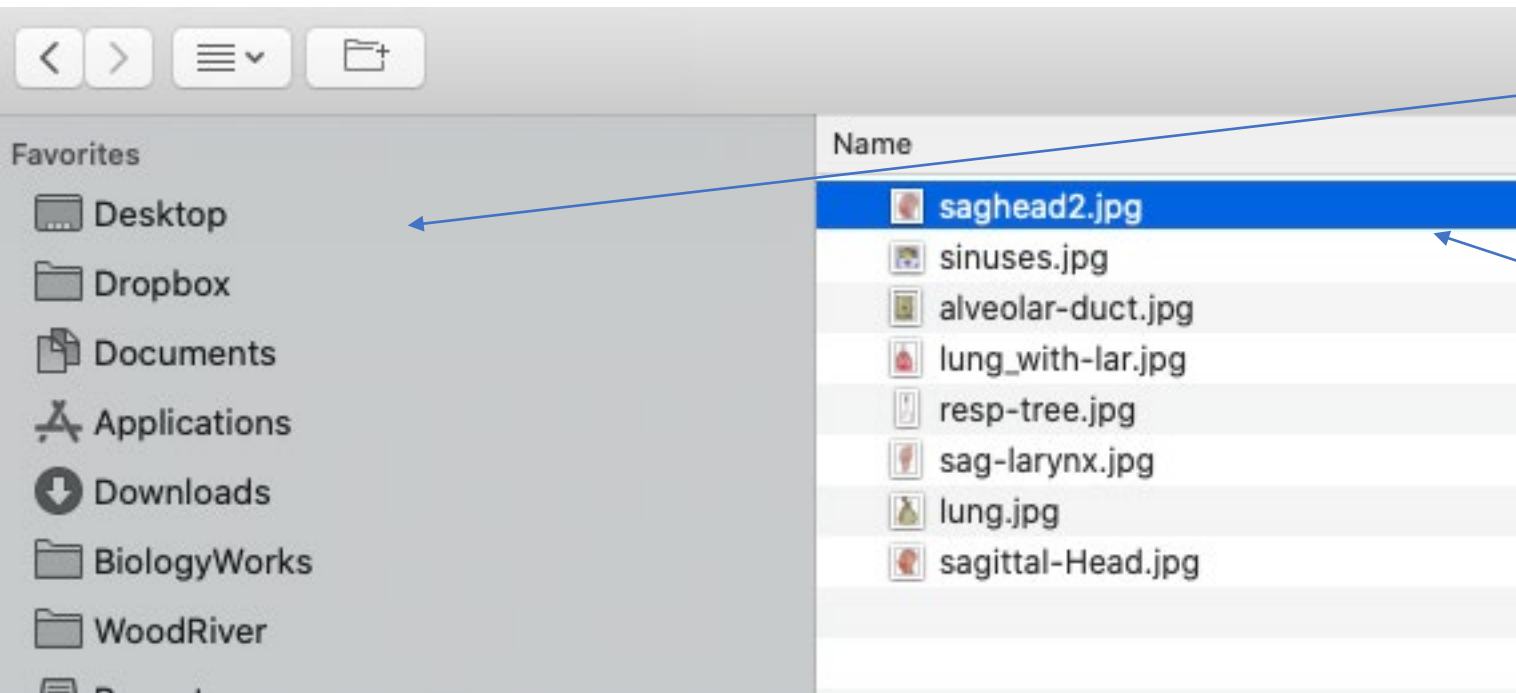
