RE: **Parking for Spring 2019**

Welcome to Middlesex County College, New Brunswick Center. You are being provided with updated parking access information pertaining to students and visitors for the 2019 Spring semester. Registered MCC students receive a student discounted rate from the New Brunswick Parking Authority (NBPA) when they purchase a parking pass for the academic semester.

There are currently two (2) parking options offered by the NBPA.

1. 2019 academic semester student discounted parking pass:

Daytime and evening students can park in the garage for \$40.00 for the academic semester. In addition, there is a one-time security deposit of \$5.00 which is refundable when the card is returned to the NBPA.

To sign up for a semester pass, students must go to the NBPA offices located at:

Students will be required to show a valid ID such as an MCC student ID or a current driver's license and a print-out of their semester's schedule. Passes will be sold for the up-coming semester only and will be valid for the New Street Deck.

At the end of each semester, **passes will be deactivated**. Students will need to return to the NBPA offices to renew their passes for the up-coming semester. Their access card must be returned to NBPA office in order for the \$5.00 security deposit to be refunded. **A \$15.00 fee** will be assessed for the replacement of a **LOST or STOLEN** access card.

2. In lieu of a pass for the semester, students may park in the NEW Street Parking deck and pay the established daily rate. **For example**, the current parking fee is \$3.00 for the first hour, \$ 6.00 for up to 2 hours, and \$8.00 for up to 4 hours. Daily parking rates are posted at every NBPA facility and can be accessed online at www.njnbpa.org/parking-info/parking-rates
